

## **Selection Criteria for the Next Generation Fellowship & Residency Training Awards Program**

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

It is the responsibility of the institution being awarded to select their trainee. ACMG Foundation has final approval over any trainee selected by the institutions to receive funding from the ACMG Foundation. Each institution can have their own selection process, as long as the trainee meets the requirements as outlined by the ABMGG. Trainees must also be lawfully residing in the United States.

The ACMG Foundation is asking institutions to pay attention to diversity, equity and inclusion when considering a candidate. This program also requires that applicants design a research project and conduct that research over the course of the program. Ideally this project will be translational in nature and applicable to advancing clinical genetic and genomic medicine. Special consideration should be given to projects that can help underrepresented groups.
